



Coleambally Church Building Appeal

Coleambally is a farming community 600km south-west of Sydney. Families have been meeting together here in their homes and rented buildings for over sixty years.

In recent years, with new families moving into the area, the church has outgrown the current rented building.

We have always held the hope of building our own church as a witness for the Lord, and with the support of the members we purchased some land in the town. Plans began to be drawn up in 2021, however COVID put a stop to any further progress, and building costs increased rapidly. We were also delayed for more than six months in Council before the building approval was granted.

Building finally began in October 2024 with the foundations being laid. Steady progress has been made with the roof now on and the brickwork completed.

Additional funds are needed to finish the interior of the structure, including flooring and painting, installing the kitchen and bathrooms, and connecting electrical services. Furniture will be needed for the sanctuary and dining hall. Lastly, the carpark and landscaping must be completed to council's standards.




